A closed-circuit countdown will begin 5 minutes prior to airtime.

All local breaks will be covered by network promos.

There will be a :05 music bed for station ID after every break.

Network will insert a :10 station ID near the top of the hour

¹ Network will send a K1 relay at the start of this 3-minute break, and then send another K1 relay after 90 seconds and a short audio bridge before playing the remaining 90 seconds of the break. Thus, each K1 relay send can be used by station to trigger a break that is a uniform length.
